# ELKINS COMMON COUNCIL REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

401 Davis Avenue Council Chamber, 2nd Floor February 5, 2015 7:00 p.m.

Elkins Common Council met in regular session in the council chamber of city hall. Present were Mayor Van T. Broughton; Councilpersons J. S. Bibey, N. E. Bross-Fregonara, M. L. Marstiller, E.R. Ochsendorf, J. J. Sabatino, M. D. Scott, and R. A. Woolwine; City Treasurer T. Fox; Fire Chief T. W. Meader; Police Chief S.D. Richards; City Attorney G. S. Roberts; City Clerk S.R. Stokes (acting as recording secretary); and Inter-Mountain Reporter C. Lee.

Councilmembers M. D. Cuonzo, C. L. Metheny, and L.E. Randall and Operations Manager R.P. Pingley were absent.

#### INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION

Laura Ward, director of the Randolph County Senior Center and Country Roads Transit, presented information about the operations and finances of the latter.

Cm. Sabatino, seconded by Cm. Woolwine, MOVED THAT COUNCIL APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 15, 2015. The motion carried.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Cm. Scott, seconded by Cm. Sabatino, MOVED THAT COUNCIL APPROVE ORDINANCE 186, A PROPOSED WATER BOND ORDINANCE, ON THE SECOND OF THREE READINGS. The motion carried.

Cm. Marstiller, seconded by Cm. Ochsendorf, MOVED THAT COUNCIL APPROVE ORDINANCE 187, A PROPOSED SEWER BOND ORDINANCE, ON THE SECOND OF THREE READINGS. The motion carried.

Cm. Woolwine, seconded by Cm. Sabatino, MOVED THAT COUNCIL APPROVE ORDINANCE 188, ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR CITY ELECTED OFFICIALS, ON SECOND AND FINAL READING. The motion carried.

Cw. Bross-Fregonara, seconded by Cm. Scott, MOVED THAT COUNCIL APPROVE ORDINANCE 189, MAKING VARIOUS REQUIRED INSERTIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO THE 2009 INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE AND THE 2012 INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE, ON THE FIRST OF THREE READINGS. The motion carried.

Cm. Bibey, seconded by Cm. Woolwine, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADOPT RESOLUTION 697, MAKING REAPPOINTMENTS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS. The motion carried.

Cm. Marstiller, seconded by Cm. Sabatino, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADOPT RESOLUTION 698, ADOPTING A POLICY THAT NEW EMPLOYEES RECEIVE FULL PAY DURING THEIR PROBATIONARY PERIODS. The motion carried.

Cm. Scott, seconded by Cm. Bibey, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADOPT RESOLUTION 699, DESIGNATING THE MUNICIPAL COURT AS THE EARLY VOTING LOCATION FOR THE 2015 MUNICIPAL ELECTION. The motion carried.

Cm. Woolwine, seconded by Cm. Marstiller, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADOPT RESOLUTION 700, AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A POOLED CASH ACCOUNT AT MOUNTAIN VALLEY BANK. The motion carried.

Cm. Ochsendorf, seconded by Cw. Bross-Fregonara, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADOPT RESOLUTION 702, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE W. VA. DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FOR SYCAMORE STREET SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS. The motion carried.

Cm. Marstiller, seconded by Cm. Ochsendorf, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADOPT RESOLUTION 703, AMENDING THE PERSONNEL MANUAL TO INCLUDE CLOSURE/LEAVE POLICIES NEAR CERTAIN HOLIDAYS. The motion carried.

Cm. Marstiller, seconded by Cm. Ochsendorf, MOVED THAT COUNCIL ENTER EXECUTIVE SESSION UNDER THE PERSONNEL EXEMPTION FOR THE AGENDA ITEM "PERSONNEL MATTER IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT." The motion carried. The executive session began at 7:30 p.m. and ended at 7:40 p.m. The mayor announced that no decisions were made and no actions were taken.

Cm. Marstiller asked Chief Richards to speak. Chief Richards announced that he would be retiring as of April 6, 2015.

Cm. Marstiller, seconded by Cm. Scott, MOVED THAT THE OPENING FOR A NEW POLICE CHIEF BE ADVERTISED IN THE INTER-MOUNTAIN. The motion carried.

#### APPROVAL OF VENDOR INVOICE PAYMENTS

Cm. Woolwine, seconded by Cm. Sabatino, MOVED THAT COUNCIL APPROVE THE INVOICES PRESENTED. The motion carried.
