The City of Elkins has developed a Source Water Protection Plan to comply with recent state legislation regarding drinking water. All public water utilities that use surface water sources must complete and submit a plan by July 1, 2016.

Source Water Protection Plans are valuable tools to help any public water system plan for and manage water emergencies. Development of these plans relies on the involvement of water utility personnel, local government officials, emergency managers, health department representatives, and local community leaders.

Your water system is committed to informing and engaging the public during development and implementation of this plan. Elkins Water Department will hold a public meeting to allow customers to review and comment on the plan. Now is your chance to provide your input.
