In accordance with West Virginia Code §3-6-9, Elkins Common Council met in special session as the Canvassing Board of the City of Elkins in the council chamber of city hall. Present were Mayor Van T. NEW BUSINESS

The city clerk announced that a demand for recount was submitted in writing by Cody H. Thompson, a candidate for the Fifth Ward council seat, within 48 hours of the declaration of the results by the Canvassing Board and along with payment of the required \$300 bond.
