Elkins Common Council met in regular session in the council chamber of city hall. Present were Mayor Van T. Broughton; Councilpersons R.C. Chenoweth, M. D. Cuonzo, C. Friddle, III, M.M. Hazen, C.C. Roberts; and City Clerk J.R. Sutton (acting as recording secretary).

Cw. L.H. Vest and City Treasurer T. Judy were absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Rhett Dusenbury, 140 Easy St, applauded the city for their use of city crews in the demolition of a dilapidated building. He encouraged officials to look for funding sources outside the state. In addition, Mr. Dusenbury encouraged city officials to adopt a protocol in the event of an internal investigation.

Cw. Cuonzo moved approval of Ordinance 242: amending the Elkins City Code Chapter 13, Section 16, Breach of Peace; Penalties (2nd and final reading). <u>The motion carried.</u>

Cm. Woolwine MOVED APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE 243: ORDINANCE TO VACATE, ABANDON AND CLOSE A PART OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY KNOWN AS STODDARD AVENUE (1ST OF TWO READINGS). Cm. Friddle recused himself from the vote due to his membership on the Randolph County Development Authority Board. The motion carried.

Cm. Metheny MOVED APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 1047: APPROVING "FULL-TIME REGULAR EMPLOYEE" STATUS AND CONFIRMING COMPENSATION LEVEL FOR O. POE. The motion carried.

Cm. Metheny moved approval of Resolution 1048: approving "Full-Time Regular Employee" status and confirming compensation level for T. Harris. The motion carried.

The City Clerk provided an update on the City's Municipal Home Rule Amendment to the Approved Written Plan, which was presented by the Clerk, the Mayor and the City Attorney to the Home Rule Board on July 25, 2017. Of the nine authorities requested, two were withdrawn by the city due to recent legislation prompting the need for further review, and the remaining seven were approved. Council was advised that they now have authority to move forward with legislation on the seven approved authorities if they so choose.
