PUBLIC COMMENT

Judy Guye of 107 Sylvester Drive asked council to consider planning for a reduction in the B&O tax in conjunction with the sales tax revenue. She believes this would be advantageous to the downtown businesses, especially if additional businesses are annexed in the future.

Rhett Dusenbury, Field Representative for Congressman Mooney, thanked council for considering requests made to assist other WV law enforcement agencies that are less fortunate. He advised that the Buckhannon Police Department recently donated a vehicle to the Calhoun County Sheriff's Department, but that Clay County and the City of Sutton are still in need.
