# ELKINS COMMON COUNCIL REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Jamie Bickel of 1010 S. Kerens Avenue addressed council regarding issues he has with his neighbor including his failure to install gutters on his house, a brush pile behind their properties which he believes to be a fire hazard, a fence that impedes his ability to see when he backs his vehicle from his driveway, and a recently issued building permit for the installation of a driveway. Mr. Bickel also believes that the City needs to address a watershed issue that is causing his home to sink.

Marly Hazen, Fourth Ward Councilor, spoke regarding a future proposal she hopes to bring to council. Ms. Hazen is suggesting that Robert E. Lee Ave be renamed to honor Katherine Johnson, a WV native known for her contributions to the world of mathematics. Ms. Hazen suggests this as a way to attract new residents and retain graduates.
