

**ELKINS COMMON COUNCIL
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
MINUTES**

Elkins Common Council met in special session jointly with the Randolph County Commission. Present from the City of Elkins were Mayor Van T. Broughton; Councilpersons: J. S. Bibey, N. E. Bross-Fregonara, M. D. Cuonzo, M. L. Marsteller, C. L. Metheny, E.R. Ochsendorf, L.E. Randall, J. J. Sabatino, M. D. Scott, and R. A. Woolwine; Police Chief S.D. Richards; City Clerk S.R. Stokes (acting as recorder); and City Attorney G. S. Roberts.

Also present was Inter-Mountain Reporter B. Johnson.

Cw. N. E. Bross-Fregonara, Operations Manager R.P. Pingley, Interim Treasurer T. Fox, and Fire Chief T. W. Meader were absent.

Present from Randolph County were: Commissioners J. Johns, M. Taylor and C. See; and Randolph County Prosecuting Attorney M. Parker.

The Randolph County Commission first convened their meeting and duly approved a motion to withdraw its letter of intent to the West Virginia Board of Public Works to purchase the Elkins National Guard Armory in partnership with the City of Elkins.

The Elkins Common Council next convened its meeting.

Cm. Marsteller, seconded by Cm. Bibey, **MOVED THAT COUNCIL ACCEPT THE COMMISSION'S WITHDRAWAL AND DIRECT THE CITY CLERK TO DOCKET FOR THE AGENDA OF THE NEXT REGULAR MEETING THE FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING THE CITY'S INTENTION TO PURCHASE THE ELKINS NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY AS SOLE OWNER.** (Cm. Woolwine abstained from the vote due to his membership on the board of directors of the Mountain State Forest Festival.) The motion carried.

Cm. Marsteller, seconded by Cm. Ochsendorf, **MOVED THAT COUNCIL ADJOURN ITS MEETING.** The motion carried.


The meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
