Elkins Common Council met in regular session in the council chamber of city hall. Present were Mayor Van T. Broughton; Councilpersons R.C. Chenoweth, M. D. Cuonzo, C.H. Friddle, III, J.A. Guye, G.M. Hinchman, C. L. Metheny, D.C. Parker, L.H. Vest, and K.L. Wilmoth; City Treasurer T. Judy; Fire Chief T. W. Meader; Police Chief T. Bennett; Operations Manager R.P. Pingley; City Attorney G. S. Roberts; City Clerk J.R. Sutton (acting as recording secretary); and Inter-Mountain Reporter B. Johnson.

Councilman C.C. Lowther was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mike Elza, 1311 S. Kerens Ave, stated that one thing that would help is knowing about all the vehicles the City owns. He sees them around but thinks the public should know what and where they are.

PRESENTATION

Maryann Durland, President of the Elkins Historic Landmarks Commission, presented information to council regarding the group's responsibilities, current major projects, and goals for next year. The commission consists of five members, two of which will be asking for reappointment in December. The group meets monthly at the Darden House.

Friddle, moved approval of Ordinance 266: An ordinance to set forth proposed sewer collection system improvement project and to amend and reenact the rates, rules and regulations for furnishing sewage and sewage disposal service at Elkins and vicinity, Randolph County, West Virginia by increasing the rates charged therefore (2nd and final reading).
