

During 2021, a City of Elkins contractor, Bear Contracting, will be excavating sections of 15 city streets to install new stormwater lines.

The purpose of this project is to reduce the volume of stormwater entering sewer lines, which can cause sewage overflows into the Tygart River.

How will this project affect sewer customers?

The impacts of the sewer/stormwater separation project will vary by street but can be expected to include changes to traffic and parking patterns and the presence of heavy equipment; this project is not expected to disrupt any customer's sewer service. Contractors will not need to enter your home or business.
